

## Participation and Spirit Award

The Spirit and Participation Award is presented annually to the school exhibiting the highest level of participation in the Wellesley North Easthope Fall Fair. An important component of the Award criteria is the number of exhibits entered in the Fair each year by students. Participation in the parade is judged for the spirit and enthusiasm demonstrated by the students and teachers involved. Judging is done on a weighted basis to eliminate any inequity due to differences in student populations.

The school adjudged with the most points for spirit and participation receives a \$200.00 cash prize to be used in the school for needs other than operating expenses. A trophy is presented at the opening ceremony of the following Fair.

### **Class 10 – Parade**

- Entry forms will be available from the parade organizers and must be turned into the fair office by 3 pm on Wednesday September 14<sup>th</sup> to receive prize money.
- The judge's decision will be final
- Absolutely no riders on farm vehicles or equipment
- No throwing of items from floats such as candy, peanuts etc. Walkers may hand out items along the parade route
- All drivers of motorized vehicles MUST have a valid driver's permit
