

CLASS 6: 4-H MEMBER DEPARTMENT

Rules and regulations:

- a. Open to youth age 9-21 as of January 1, current year and enrolled in a 4-H Club in 2016
- b. Cloverbud Program open to youth 6-8 years of age as of January 1 of the current year and enrolled in Cloverbud 4-H in 2016.
- c. No entry fee required
- d. You must register at the office or online for an exhibitor's number to be able to receive your prize money
- e. All food items must be on a disposable plate and in an appropriately sized plastic bag.
- f. Please record your 4-H Club Name and 4-H enrolment number on the entry form. Club Team entries excepted.
- g. Posters must be hand drawn
- h. Poster size: Min. 8 ½" x 11" (22cm x 28cm) to a Max. 11" x 17" (28 cm x 44 cm)
