

RULES

1. Membership is \$6.00 per year.
2. Exhibitors are restricted to Ontario residents only. The judging in the hall will commence at 11 am on Tuesday. Horses judged at 11:00 am on Wednesday. Other livestock 1:00 pm Wednesday. Parties taking prize money amounting to \$6.00 or more are compelled to leave \$6.00 with the secretary for next year's membership. This also applies to special prizes. All cheques not cashed by November 30th in the year awarded, will become the property of the Society. Secretary will send cheques for prize money by mail.
3. Any persons found guilty of violating any part of the rules will forfeit their whole prize money.
4. The exhibitor agrees to indemnify and have harmless the society and the township of Wellesley from and against all loss or damage by reason of the use by the user. The exhibitor must have proof of certificate of not less than \$1,000,000. Exhibitors include all livestock, commercial and midway participants. The directors reserve the right to deny participation to those without proper insurance coverage
5. EVERYTHING, EXCEPTING LIVESTOCK AND IMPLEMENTS, MUST BE ON GROUNDS OR IN THE BUILDING BY 10:30 O'CLOCK A.M. ON TUESDAY, AND REMAIN UNTIL 4:30 O'CLOCK P.M. ON THE FOLLOWING DAY OR PRIZE MONEY MAY BE FORFEITED, ALL LIVESTOCK MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS BY 11:00 O'CLOCK A.M. ON WEDNESDAY, AND REMAIN IN THEIR DESIGNATED TIE AREA UNTIL 4:00 P.M. OR PRIZE MONEY MAY BE FORFEITED.
6. While directors will take every possible precaution under circumstances to secure the safety of the articles sent to the exhibition, the owners themselves must take the risk of exhibiting, and should any article be accidentally injured, lost or stolen, the directors will give any aid in their power towards its recovery, but will not make payment for value thereof.
7. The decision of the judges shall be final as to the awarding of prizes and no appeal will be considered except in case of protest. All protests shall be made in writing, and shall be delivered within one hour of the award to the secretary's office. Any exhibitor or interested person making such protest will be required to deposit the sum of \$25.00 and if such protest is not sustained, the said sum shall be retained by the association. The directors serve the right in all cases to interpret their own rules.
8. No person will be allowed to take more than one prize in any one section. This does not apply to livestock
9. No person shall be allowed in the show room during the time of inspection by the judges, excepting the officers of the society
10. Each exhibitor is required to complete an entry form and return it to the office by the time judging has started. Entry forms can be found on line or in the fair book. Assistance to complete entry form and tags will be available at the Fair in the Community Centre.

11. Please refer to rules at the beginning of each class. All grain, seeds, roots, and garden products must have been grown in the course of this year, and by the exhibitor. All manufactured articles must have been made by the exhibitor and must be up to date. Crafts can only be shown once at the Wellesley North Easthope fall Fair. Antiques and collectables must be owned by the exhibitor or a member of the exhibitor family. Any person violating this rule will forfeit all prizes taken at the show. If you are a newcomer to showing at the fair we will have a team in the community centre during the hours of entry acceptance to assist you with the entry tags and forms and/or answer your questions.

12. In cases where there is no competition, or livestock not in proper condition, it is left to the judge to award first, second, or third prize, according to merit

13. All stock, with the exception of 4-H animals, and produce entered must be the property of the person in whose name it is entered. In case of protest, an affidavit will be demanded. All exhibits, except livestock, must be the product of the exhibitor or his / her family. No bought or borrowed goods or articles will be allowed.

14. No stud, except foals and yearlings, shall be allowed to show with geldings. Any exhibitor showing a stud does so at own risk.

15. A certificate of pedigree is required for purebred cattle

16. All bulls and other wild and vicious animals must be well secured before entering the field of exhibition

Privacy
